Cost of living

Most items and services are available in both countries.

How far does your money go?

Three items: a candy bar, bag of chips, and coke are compared and are cheaper in the US. ¹

Clubbing is available in both countries, as are movies.² The cost of seeing a movie is more in the UK than in the US.³ The average ticket price in the US is \$7.50 or 4.87716 GBP.⁴

Gasoline is cheaper in the US.⁵ Cars are cheaper in the US than in the UK, on average costing only half as much. ⁶ Electronics such as laptops, cameras, and phones are cheaper in the US⁷

Community: <http://www.usa-vs-uk.com/community.html> rates Americans as more friendly than British. Then he says it is hard to meet Americans because most friendships are made at work, in school, or through mutual friends. He says that for people under 21 years of age it is hard to meet Americans because minors can't go to bars or clubs where alcohol is served¹⁰ He rates the US lifestyle less hectic and more relaxed than the UK.¹¹

Restaurants are abundant in both countries. He prefers the taste of British sandwiches to American sandwiches, but gives a rave review of American restaurants in general.¹²

" Restaurants in the uk (*sic.*) are similar to American versions except with a larger price tag," he says.

Fishing and boating are cheaper in the US. Lakes in the US are larger than in the UK, so boating is in lakes more accessible in the US. In the UK he recommends boating in the sea.¹³

There is more land for recreational vehicles in the US than in the UK.¹⁴

Clothes are cheaper in the US than in the UK.¹⁵

Is car insurance cheaper in the US? He thinks so, but he did not compare the same model of car, so we would need to do further research.¹⁶

Healthcare is private and unaffordable to some in the US, but emergency care is guaranteed for all. Healthcare in the UK is free.¹⁷



Tuition and Payments
